## Sacrificial Law/Mosaic/"Circumcision" (Ceremonial Law)

**Written by Moses** (Deuteronomy 31:24)

**Written By Moses In A Book/Scrolls** (2 Chronicles 35:12)

**Placed BESIDE the Ark** (Deuteronomy 31:26)

**Given at Mt Sinai** (Deuteronomy 29:1)

**Added because of sin** (Galatians 3:19)

**Meant to Expire When Christ would come** (Galatians 3:19)

**God calls 'Not good'** (Ezekiel 20:24-25, Colossians 2:14)

**Against Us** (Deuteronomy 31:26)

**Carnal** (Hebrews 7:12-16)

**Abolished/Ended at the Cross** (Ephesians 2:15)

**Contrary to Us, Against Us** (Colossians 2:14)

**It's 'Wiped Out'/Will Not Be Judging No One** (Colossians 2:14-16)

**Made Nothing Perfect** (Hebrews 7:16)

## 10 Commandments ("Moral Law")

**Written by God/Finger of God himself** (Deuteronomy 4:13)

**Written by God in Stone (It's Permanent)** (Exodus 31:18; 32:16)

**Given at Mt Horeb** (Deuteronomy 4:13)

**Placed INSIDE the Ark** (Exodus 25:16)

**Intended to be sufficient by self/No More Added** (Deuteronomy 5:22)

**Reveals/Points Out Sin In Us** (Romans 7:7; 3:20)

**Holy, Just, Good** (Romans 7:12)

**Law of Liberty** (James 2:12)

**Will Stand Forever** (Luke 16:17)

**The "Angel" who spoke with Moses was Jesus himself who gave us the 10 Commandments** (Acts 7:37-38)

**Will Be Standard of What Judges People** (James 2:10-12; John 12:48)

**Eternal** (Psalms 111:7-8)

**Intended to be Kept for a thousand generations** (Deuteronomy 7:9)

**Keep All Commandments that it would go well with you** (Deuteronomy 5:29)

**Spiritual** (Romans 7:14)

**Perfect** (Psalms 19:17)

**Not Voided/Cancelled- Still Legally binded/Upheld through faith** (Romans 3:31)

**Not One letter will disappear from Law until Christ Comes Back** (Matthew 5:17-18)

**Never be Removed** (Isaiah 54:10)

**If Obeyed, God will be your God and You will be his people** (Deuteronomy 4-5)

**Called 'Mercy'** (Exodus 20:6, Luke 1:72)

**He who turns away from the law, even his prayer is abomination** (Proverbs 28:9)

**Don't Break the covenant** (Psalm 89:34)
